Heifer International, located in Arkansas, uses donations to provide livestock and education to help struggling families and communities become self-reliant, serving 21 countries including the United States.

This gift not only provides food for the family but also allows them to earn income for basic life necessities such as medicine and school. And it's not just cows that they provide. Over the years they have distributed fish, chickens, pigs, goats, sheep, cattle, oxen, water buffaloes, bees, llamas, alpacas, camels, rabbits, and yes, even frogs. Giving an animal is like giving someone a small business, providing wool, milk, eggs and more.

Giving To God's Work

IRA Charitable Rollover

This is quite simply a golden opportunity to make gifts directly to our church from your IRA (individual retirement account).

Why you should do this:

- It counts toward the required minimum distribution (RMD) but is not counted as additional taxable income.
- There is no tax deduction, so no need to itemize. This is great for donors who do not itemize deductions.
- For those who itemize and have already reached the limit on annual charitable deductions, this gift has no adverse impact on your taxes.
- It is an easy way to make a cash gift and preserve non-cash assets.
- By doing this transfer directly to our church you reduce the taxes you have to pay on your RMD. For example, if you are in a 22 percent tax bracket and make a donation of \$5,000 directly to our church you would save \$1,100 in taxes. In making a gift this way it only costs you \$3,900 for a \$5,000 gift.
