Church serves, fills food pantry

The church has fully filled all the slots for manning the food pantry through the entire month of August. The response has been tremendous. The sign-up process online and in person has worked very well this year. Thank you for such a tremendous effort.

The food pantry still needs additional help to stock the shelves with supplies. The economic issues are depleting the supplies: (1) the nation ended the supplemental supplies due to the pandemic, (2) truck drivers are not available, and (3) Harvestors cannot supply about 50% of what they had been providing.

Add to the supply issues, the demands are up. The numbers continue to rise for not only the families, but for the homeless that are in the community. Therefore, the following items are needed:

- Canned vegetables except for corn and green beans
- Boxed dinner products such as Hamburger Helper
- Boxed cereals
- Individual, pre-packaged meal items (esp. to meet the homeless needs)
- Small hygiene items
- Paper products

Another major problem is the lack of meat products primarily due to the change in policies from government sources and Harvestors. Monetary donations can help the local food pantry purchase additional meats to provide the clients.

The food cans are in the atrium ready for any products you may bring in. Feel free to stop by any time during the week to leave them in the cans.

Monetary donations can be done online through the webpage [umc**burg**](http://umcburg). Of course you may mail them in to the office at 141 E. Gay Street, Warrensburg, MO 60493, or we can always accept them during worship. On the checks, just add to the memo that it is for the FOOD PANTRY.
