National: The United Women in Faith Northwest District supports the local units with resources and opportunities for spiritual growth, training, and mission participation. Jana Miller is the President of the Northwest District UWF. The District UWF hosts Spring and Fall Meetings, distributes a monthly newsletter, holds Book Reads, Spiritual Growth Retreats, and has yearly awards for Woman in Mission and for participating in the Mission Today criteria. UWF supports justice and equal opportunities for all and the healing of our environment. The Northwest UWF Fall meeting is October 14, 2023, at Summit Church in Lee's Summit, Missouri. The Missouri Conference: UWF supports the district and local units and provides a link to the National UWF. There is an annual meeting in the Fall, this year on September 22-23 at Grace UMC, Lee's Summit. Every two years a Legislative Training Event is held at Jefferson City, where UWF participants are supplied with information on state and national policies that UWF members are concerned with. The Conference also sponsors Mission u, a national program, which is an opportunity for reflection and informal action through education opportunities and resources for men, women, youth and children. First UMC was the host church in July 2023 for this year's Mission u,and will also be the host church for 2024. Over 80 participants from around the state, including several of our members, attended this year. UWF Reading Program: The UWF Reading Program is a cherished tradition. This program encourages members to think critically about current issues through an annual selection of member-reviewed books and offers an opportunity to deepen spirituality and broaden understanding of mission work. New reading lists are selected each year. The First UMC UWF Reading Library is located on the second floor of the church in the hallway across from the chapel. New books are ordered each year, at least one from each of the five categories, including youth and children's books. These categories are **Education for Mission**, **Leadership Development**, Nurturing for Community, Social Action, and Spiritual Growth.
